Jellystone Park" at Kozy Rest Camper Personal Responsibility Code

I understand that Yogi Bear's Jellystone Park at Kozy Rest is a family oriented park and that they want everyone to have fun, enjoy the facilities and have a relaxing stay. I will respect the other campers and the park facilities. I am responsible for my children's actions, and I will make sure everyone in my party abides by all posted regulation signage throughout the Camp-Resort.

Visitors: For everyone's safety, I will register all my visitors at the office, pay the day use fee, and pick up a visitor pass to be displayed in their vehicle <u>BEFORE</u> entering the park. I will make sure my visitors leave by 10PM. I am responsible for the actions of my visitors and will inform all members of my camping party of the policies of the Camp-Resort. I will make sure my visitors do not bring pets into the park. I understand it is one unit per site and adding a tent will add an additional charge.

Pets: Kozy Rest welcomes pets, and I will be considerate of my neighbors in caring for my pet. I will always keep my pet on a leash, keep them quiet, and never leave them unattended at any point. I will always take my furry friend with me when leaving the campground. I understand pets are not permitted in buildings or rental units unless otherwise designated. Doggie bags are provided throughout the park. I will always clean up after my pet. Nothing spoils a day more than poop-on-a-rug. I know any pet that shows aggression must be removed immediately. Quiet Hours: 11PM-8AM daily. I will be considerate of those around me.

Quiet Hours: 11PM-8AM daily. I will be considerate of those around me. My children under 18 will be at the campsite by 10PM unless escorted by an adult. I understand anyone causing noise that can be heard outside of my campsite boundary, using profanity, or causing a disturbance will cause me to be asked to leave without a refund. All music must be turned off at 10PM and should never beheard outside of my campsite at any time. **Trespassing:** I will make sure everyone from my site will use the roads and paths and will not shortcut through anyone else's campsite.

and paths and will not shortcut through anyone else's campsite. **Bicycles/Motorized Vehicles:** Riding bikes is great fun, and lunderstand it is state law for children under 12 to always ride with a helmet on. I will make sure for everyone's safety, all bikes will be parked when the street lights come on. I understand I cannot use quads, dirt bikes, power wheels, electric scooters, hover boards, or golf carts. I will only use our ELECTRIC RC vehicles on the designated tracks and understand that gas powered are not permitted to be used on property. I understand that motorcycle/moped use is limited to in and out of the park only.

Speed Limit 5 MPH—Children are precious, and my guests and I will not exceed 5MPH and we will watch out for children because we know they are not watching for us.

Parking: We will only have 2 vehicles on our site and will park all others in designated parking areas.

Alcoholic Beverages: We will keep alcoholic beverages on site and in a koozie at all times and will not have any kegs.

Comfort Stations & Buildings: All children in my party will be accompanied by an adult inside all buildings. We will not smoke in any buildings or rental units and will not wash dothes, dishes, or utensils in comfort stations. Shoes and shirts will be worn in buildings.

Campsites: We will conserve water and electricity when possible and will check for dripping hoses and turn off string lights before retiring. We will use a sewer collar and will not discharge gray water on the ground. We will not wash our RV or vehicles. We understand there is one picnic table provided per site and will get permission before moving tables site to site. **Trash:** We understand that all trash must not be left out overnight and must be disposed of in the dumpster by the exit gate. We will not dispose of any largenon-camping trash items such as tires, furniture, bicycles, etc. **Campfires:** We will only have a campfire inside the designated fire ring and understand there is a \$50 fine for moving fire rings. We will only burn firewood and not garbage and will put out our fire before retiring for the evening. At the request of the Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture's by not bringing firewood onto campground property. Fireworks/Firearms: We will not possess or use fireworks, firearms, archery equipment, slingshots, BB, airsoft or paintball guns on Kozy Rest property and understand we will be asked to leave without a refund if we do.

Wi-Fi: Signal strength may vary depending on demand, my location, and my device since we are in a rural, wooded area. We will not view inappropriate content publicly and realize we will be blocked if we do. **Pool Safety:** WE UNDERSTAND THERE ARE NOT ANY LIFEGUARDS, AND WE WILLSWIM AT OUR OWN RISK. We will not allow any children under 12 in the pool area without adult supervision. We will not dive, will follow all posted rules at the pool, will use common sense and will be responsible while using the pool area.

To assure the enjoyment of other campers who follow my group, I will do my best to keep all facilities and grounds clean, will be litter free and will place all cigarette butts where they belong.

Acknowled gment of Risk and Personal Responsibility Expectations: I UNDERSTAND THAT YOGI BE ARS JELLYSTONE PARK AT KOZY REST IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGE, THEFT, OR LOSS OF CAMPER'S POSSESSIONS. KOZY REST KAMPGROUND, ITS FACILITIES, ITS MANAGEMENT, AND EMPLOYEES SHALL BE HELD HARMLESS FROM ANY ACT AND IS NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY DAMAGES TO CAMPER, WHETHER DAMAGED BY VIRTUE OF MANOR BY AN ACT OF GOD.

We understand the park enforces their rules to protect their guests and their park, and the resort reserves the right to evict any person who violates any laws, policies, rules, regulations or creates a disturbance in any way and <u>no refunds will be issued</u>,
